Teachers' feedback to the phonics workshops

- 1. Most teachers slightly agreed that the workshops enriched their knowledge in phonics.
- 2. Most teachers did not agreed that the workshops enriched their knowledge in the teaching of phonics.
- 3. Most teachers did not think they could apply the activities in the workshops to classroom situations.
- 4. Most teachers did not think that they could apply examples in the workshops in class.
- 5. Most teachers found the pace of the workshops inappropriate.
- 6. Most teachers did not found the instructor effective.
- 7. Most teachers did not think the instructor had a good awareness of the target audience.

Strengths of the workshops:

- 1. Phonics rules were taught.
- 2. Game and activities were interesting.
- 3. Worksheets were well-designed.
- 4. Activities to be used in class were introduced.

Areas to improve on:

- 1. There should be more activities suitable for running in classroom situation in HK, especially, for large classes and senior forms.
- 2. More phonics rules should be taught.
- 3. The instructor should stick to the plan of the workshops.
